

Tardies are counted on an overall basis (as opposed to per class period). This means it is possible for a student to be tardy four times in a single day. For the purposes of progressive discipline, tardies will reset at the semester.

PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE

| 1ST TARDY: | Verbal warning from teacher |
| 2ND TARDY: | Verbal warning from teacher |
| 3RD TARDY: | Parent contact from the Student Success Center (SSC), warning of Insubordination and detention on subsequent tardies |
| 4TH TARDY: | Parent notification from the SSC, Insubordination and detention assigned |
| 5TH TARDY: | Parent notification from the SSC, two detentions assigned for continued Insubordination |
| 6TH - 8TH TARDIES: | In-house assigned for Insubordination, and student is placed on Ineligibility |

Students with nine (9) or more tardies will continue to receive IHS and will also be placed on behavioral probation. Parents/guardians and students are expected to monitor attendance in Infinite Campus.
