DANCE CONSERVATORY DRESS CODE

REQUIRED FEMALE DANCE ATTIRE

- 1. Pink tights (minimum 2 pairs)
 - 2. Pink ballet slippers
 - 3. Black leotard (minimum 3)

4. Black sports bra

- 5. Black ankle-length jazz pants or leggings
- 6. Black split-sole jazz shoes (NO JAZZ SNEAKERS)
- 7. Black full-length footless or stir-up tights (minimum 3 pairs

8. Black tee shirt (2), black sweats or workout pants, black sweat shirt no logos on any of these items)

9. One nude camisole leotard with clear straps (to be worn under some costumes)

REQUIRED MALE DANCE ATTIRE

- 1. Black footless men's tights (minimum 4 pairs)
 - 2. Black or white ballet slippers
 - 3. One black male leotard
- 4. Quilted men's dance belt (black or tan, minimum 3)
 - 5. Black biker shorts
- 6. Black basketball shorts with no logos or stripes (Not to hang below your knee)
 - 8. Black Ribbed, fitted men's T-shirt, Tank or short sleeves (3-4 suggested)
 - 9. Black split-sole jazz shoes (NO JAZZ SNEAKERS)
 - 10. One pair of black dress slacks (needed for performances)
- All Block Classes must be dressed in all-black tops and bottoms for both males and females.
- Elective Classes dress code is as follows All electives still must maintain a black clothing dress code. If tee shirts or sweats or shorts are allowed they must be solid black clothing. Students may not wear other colors except on Friday if so stated by the elective teacher.
- For your safety, jewelry is NEVER permitted during dance class. Please leave valuable jewelry at home so it does not become lost or stolen.

The Las Vegas Academy Dance Conservatory is not responsible for missing items.

Students should not add piercings, tattoos, or change hair color before consulting with their teacher and receiving permission. **Doing so could result in being pulled from a concert piece.**

<u>Please label all clothing and shoes with your name on them so if they are left in the</u> <u>studio or if someone picks up the wrong clothing they can be returned to you.</u>

PARENT FUNDING AGREEMENT

As we celebrate another year at the Las Vegas Academy of the Arts, we are again reminded of how fortunate we are to be part of the LVA Family. We already know how special our school is and what a wonderful educational opportunity it gives our students to excel in their conservatory majors, express themselves artistically, and develop into young adults well-prepared for their future academic, cultural, and professional endeavors.

While LVA has enjoyed great success since its establishment in 1993, the financial costs of providing a vital education in the liberal, performing, and visual arts have skyrocketed. To achieve the school's vision of becoming the premier arts school in the nation, we organized the Friends of Las Vegas Academy of the Arts ("Friends"). The LVA Foundation is a registered 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation, governed by a volunteer board of parents, staff, and prominent business and cultural leaders. The Foundation is a non-profit organization dedicated to the financial support of the school's tuition-free arts programs. It is responsible for directing the annual Parent Funding Agreement, legacy giving and capital fundraising efforts, providing marketing resources, leading strategic planning efforts, creating major student performance opportunities, and implementing community outreach programs. The funds they raise assist in covering costs necessary for our students to excel in their academic and artistic activities that are not covered by the regular CCSD budget.

Each conservatory major has created a budget of projected expenses for the coming school year. When we divide that amount by the number of students enrolled in that major, we calculated an amount on the Parent Funding Agreement) that, if paid by each family, would meet the financial needs of the conservatory. For the Dance Conservatory, we have recently spent a considerable amount these past two years just to get the technical equipment we needed to go virtual, as well as sourcing out to keep our lighting rig in the PAC working properly. The monies you donate will always go back into the dance account to support any future technical needs as well as costumes, lighting, and other technical needs for all dance concerts in the future. We do ask that if your family is in a position to donate more to your student's major or conservatory, you consider this. You will help ensure that we can provide the most enrichment opportunities for our students.

This tax-deductible contribution will cover all budget expenses, EXCEPT for any uniform, travel costs, and elective class fees outside of your major. The beautiful thing about your PFA contribution is that 100% of the money goes directly to your child's conservatory major.

DANCE CONSERVATORY FEES

****The LVA parent funding agreement covers all dance fees. If you choose to pay into the LVA Parent Funding Agreement you will receive a personal code to use for purchasing four tickets per dance concert event.

If you do not wish to contribute the conservatory fee then you agree and understand that you will be responsible for the annual dance fees listed:

Senior Choreography Fee = \$30 costume fee per class
All dance majors are placed in 1 block class and 1 elective, totaling \$60.

If you have requested and been placed in a second elective, you will have an extra \$30 costume fee totaling \$90.

Students keep these costumes after this concert.

- <u>All fees are paid directly through the school banker by the first day</u> of November. Students may be pulled from participating in the Senior Concert if the fees are not paid in time.
- Failure to pay fees will also result in a school fine and not being cleared for graduation.
